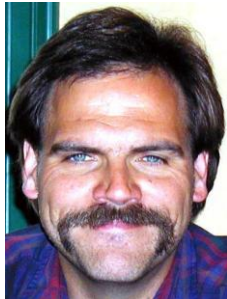

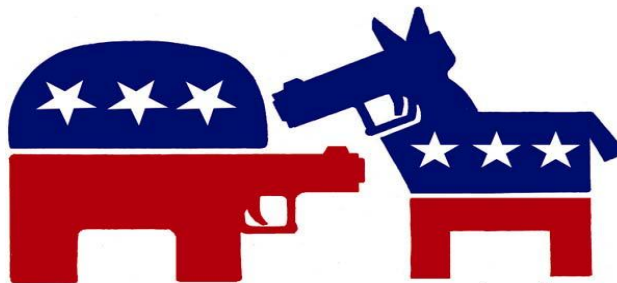
If you haven't heard Trish, you do not want to miss this opportunity. If you have heard her, I'm sure you will be there just to hear her again.
